The integrated Foundation Stage model

Although all of the Foundation Stage team have a class base for 2014-15 the team will all work across different parts of the phase. This will ensure all of the children benefit from the different areas of expertise and knowledge within the wider team.

Key Stage 1 Teaching assistants

Year 1 classes each have a full time teaching assistant. In Year 2 teaching assistant support is provided in the morning with the additional adults working with strategic groups across the two classes in the afternoons.

Key Stage 2 Teaching assistants

Teaching assistants in Lower and Upper Key Stage 2 are deployed strategically across all 7 classes. Classes will have between 2 and 3 hours teaching assistant support in the morning with further strategic deployment across the phase in the afternoon.
