

A new school year

We have great pleasure in presenting our staffing model for the school year 2013-2014. We are excited and motivated by the challenges and opportunities that the new school year will bring.

The integrated Foundation Stage model

Although all of the Foundation Stage team have a class base for 2013-14 the team will all work in different parts of the phase. This will be to ensure all of the children benefit from the different areas of expertise and knowledge within the wider team.

Key Stage 1 Teaching assistants – Year 1 have a full time teaching assistant. In Year 2 teaching assistant support is provided in the morning with the additional adult working with strategic groups across the two classes in the afternoons.

Key Stage 2 Teaching assistants

Teaching assistants in Lower and Upper Key Stage 2 are deployed strategically across all 6 classes. Classes will have between 2 and 3 hours teaching assistant support in the morning with further strategic deployment across the phase in the afternoon.

We will outline the further details of our leadership structure in future newsletters.

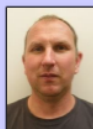
